Subject: City of New Berlin Radionuclide Consent Order

Dear Mayor Wysocki:

The Department has reviewed the February 12, 2004 letter written by Steven H. Schultz on behalf of the City of New Berlin that requests changes to Consent Order #2003-SEEE-105.

First, we agree that it is prudent to delay submission of a request (item #1 in the Consent Order) to serve the City with Lake Michigan water until further decisions are made on Great Lakes issues. We also agree that the other terms of the Consent Order should be followed until a decision is made to submit a request to serve the City with Lake Michigan water.

Second, we agree to change the completion dates for items # 9 and 21 in the Consent Order to January 31, 2005 with the understanding that it will not affect the attainment of final compliance with the Consent Order by December 8, 2006.

Unless the City prefers that a revised Consent Order be routed for signatures, this letter will serve as documentation of our mutual agreement to modify conditions 1, 9 and 21 of the January 21, 2004 Consent Order as referenced in the preceding paragraphs.
